4. The National Disciplinary Committee sat on the 5th and 12th May, 2019 to decide on 5 (five) disciplinary complaints:

- 1 (one) complaint was non-adherence to the Party's Constitution by holding dual official positions, standing for election into an office that was not vacant, and, causing disaffection amongst the members. The Respondent was expelled by the Disciplinary Committee
- 2 (two) complaints were premised on persistent absenteeism from meetings and failure to redeem voluntary financial pledges.
- 2 (two) complaints were a lack of commitment and persistent absenteeism from meetings.
