

The Federal High Court, Abuja, on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, before Justice I.E. Ekwo, delivered a judgement in favour of our Party restraining INEC from any attempt to deregister our Party until it has fully participated in the 2023 election cycle.




Mr. Tomiwa Aladekomo and Ms Aisha Modibo have been appointed as the Acting National Chair and Deputy National respectively by the National Executive Committee on 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2020.


The fourth meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2020 via teleconference to discuss the following:
