INEC Finally Obeys the Rule of Law on Youth Party

INEC on Wednesday 12th July, 2023, finally listed Youth Party on its website as one of the registered political parties in Nigeria. This was almost 3 years after our Party secured a judgement of the Federal High Court Abuja delivered by Hon. Justice I.E. Ekwo on 10th October,2020, declaring the purported deregisteration by INEC as illegal null & void. And, almost 9 months after the Supreme Court of Nigeria affirmed the judgement on 2nd December,2022.



You will recall that INEC still excluded our Party from the general election despite the decisions by all the tiers of court in flagrant breach and contempt of the law and its oath of political neutrality.

We hope this will be the beginning of a new Dawn where our members would be afforded a political level playing field to compete with other political parties in all upcoming elections.

Dr. Zainab Olaitan has been appointed as been appointed as our Director, Research & Policy.

Interestingly, Dr. Zainab Olaitan, started her career with a stint with YP's Research & Policy Unit in 2017 before proceeding abroad for further studies.

Zainab had a 1st Class degree in Political Science from the University of Lagos. And, completed her 2nd degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics Honors at the University of Cape Town as a 2018 Mandela Rhodes Scholar. In 2019, she was selected for the Mastercard foundation scholarship to study for a Masters in Political Science at the University of Pretoria. Her master's dissertation was on women's participation in peace building in West Africa, using Sierra Leone as a case study.

In 2022, she was awarded the Margaret McNamara Education Grant for her impactful research work on women and children. Zainab is an avid researcher with published articles in journals, book projects, policy briefs across different themes on political thought, gender and representation, conflict and peace studies, African politics and African Indigenous Knowledge System (AIKS).

Zainab recently completed her PhD degree in Political Science looking at the impact of gender quotas on the substantive representation of women in African politics.

Her doctoral thesis interrogated the assumption that women's increased participation in politics improves the life of women substantively.

NEC Appoints External Auditors




